Remove the stock fasteners shown in PIC.1; the one marked PIC 1
"A" will be re-used.

STEP 3 Install the stock fastener in the rear cover. Place an aluminum locating washer over the protruding end of the fastener (FIG 1); ensure that the round side of the washer is facing toward the hole in the primary chain case.

STEP 4 Slide the rear inner primary cover into place and loosely secure it with the stock fastener.

STEP 5 Position the front cover over the rear cover; ensure that the hole in the front cover fits over the threaded stud in the rear cover, see PIC.2.

STEP 6 Install the included $1/4-20 \times 1.5''$ and $1/4''-20 \times 5''$ fasteners in the front cover. Place an aluminum locating washer over the protruding end of each 1/4''-20 fastener (FIG 1); ensure that the round side of the washer is facing toward the hole in the primary chain case.

STEP 7 Secure the covers together with the included acorn nut; leave the nut finger tight for now.

NOTE: Ensure that the covers are properly aligned and that they do not interfere with the shift linkage.

STEP 8 Torque all three of the Socket Head Cap Screws to 108-120 in-lbs.

STEP 9 Tighten the acorn nut.

STEP 10 Push the Hot Spots into the four screw heads shown in PIC.3.


STEP 11 Ensure proper clearance of moving parts before operating the motorcycle.


CAUTION! Ensure that the installation of this product does not interfere with the proper operation of the motorcycle


before riding.
