STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.


STEP 2

As shown in PIC 1, locate the left and right side (sitting on the bike) Lower Leg Deflectors.

STEP 3

Clean the mounting area on the lower fork tubes thoroughly. PIC 2 If they are extremely dirty, clean the mounting area with a mild soap and warm water. Make sure that the mounting area is clear of any contaminants to ensure proper adhesion. Rinse and dry the area with clean water and dry completely.

ATTENTION! Ensure the area of installation is free of grease, oil, dirt or other debris to ensure proper adhesion. Küryakyn WILL NOT issue a warranty on any parts lost due to improper installation.

STEP 4 Clean the mounting area with the supplied alcohol pad to remove any residue and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

NOTE: Gently spread the Fender Boss Cover when fitting to the fork to prevent scratching the fork leg. You may want to apply some masking tape to the edges of the Fender Boss cover to prevent any scratching or marring of the fork leg. Make sure to center the holes in the Fender Boss Cover over the fender bolts to ease fender removal.


STEP 5 As shown in PIC 3, test fit the Fender Boss Cover to the fender boss area of the fork tubes. Using masking tape, mark the area of best fit to aid in final installation.

PIC 2 CLEAN THIS AREA ON BOTH SIDES

ATTENTION! The adhesive will not bond correctly if applied at temperatures less than 50°F. Do not attempt this installation in temperatures less than 50°F.

It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that there is adequate clearance between the Fender Boss Cover and any painted surfaces. Küryakyn is not responsible for any damage due to inadequate clearance.

Rub the adhesive backing on the Fender Boss Cover to activate the adhesive. Make sure to center the holes in the Fender Boss Cover over the fender bolts. Remove the adhesive backing and apply the Fender Boss Cover to the fender boss. Hold them in place for one minute, full bonding strength will occur in 24 hours.



NOTE: The Lower Leg Deflectors can be installed with the lower fork tube reflectors installed or removed.
