
PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

INSTALLATION FOR GL 1800

STEP 2 Remove the rear panel to access trailer mount. Refer to owner's manual.

STEP 3 Locate the bolts on the bottom of the Kuryakyn Trailer Hitch Receiver Plate. (PIC 1). For installation of the Receptacle Bracket, you will need to locate the three Receiver Plate fasteners opposite of the Ball Mount Pin. Ensure that the installed Receptacle Bracket will not interfere with removal of the Ball Mount Pin.

STEP 4 Remove the center bolt from the Receiver Plate, on the side opposite of the Pin. Line the single mount hole up to the bolt hole, reinstall the bolt through the Receptacle Bracket, into the Receiver Plate.

STEP 5 Reinstall the back panel removed in Step 2.

INSTALLATION FOR UNIVERSAL APPLICATIONS

(May require drilling)

STEP 2 Locate an easily accessible area for the trailer plug. Ensure that where it is mounted allows for the access cover to be fully opened. The access cover must open fully to allow the plug to be inserted.

NOTE: If considering installation of the Bracket to the rear fender, be sure to compress the suspension to ensure proper clearance before making any permanent mounting location.

STEP 3 Fasten the Receptacle Bracket to the bike using any of the three mounting holes provided on the Bracket. (Hardware not included)

STEP 4 Check for clearance issues. Ensure the Bracket and Wiring is not exposed to heat, potential pinch points, or moving parts.

WIRING HARNESS PLUGS:

To install the wiring harness for your application, remove the two Phillips screws on the receptacle to gain access to the wiring pins.
