STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the

ignition. Let cool.

WARNING! YOU WILL BE WORKING AROUND THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST

SYSTEM DURING INSTALLATION. ENSURE THAT THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST SYSTEM HAVE FULLY COOLED TO PREVENT

INJURY.

starting this procedure.

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
- To ease installation and prevent scratching the cover, it is recommended to remove the rear exhaust pipe. Remove the button head screw that holds the cover that protects the ECU, then slide the cover out. This cover is directly behind the rear cylinder head. Remove the oxygen sensor harness and other harness from the slots in the cover. Unplug the rear oxygen sensor connector. PIC 2 Remove the cover and set aside, it will be reused.
- STEP 3 Remove the three socket head cap screws that secure the pulley cover. Remove the pulley cover. PIC 3
- Remove the nylock nut from the bottom stud on the starter that holds the oil line retainer and remove the retainer. PIC 4 Unsnap the plastic oil line separator and remove. Remove the plastic cap from the top starter stud. PIC 4 Set these aside, they will not be reused.
- STEP 5 Using the supplied cable tie, arrange the oil lines as shown in PIC 5 and wrap the cable tie around them. **DO NOT** tighten the cable tie so tight as to compress the oil lines, just snug will do. Install the included Protective Sheathing over the top oil line. PIC 6
- STEP 6

 Install the included 10-24 socket head cap screw through the back side of the included bracket, thread the spacer on and tighten securely. This will face out from the bracket. Remove the top front and rear bolt from the solenoid cover and install the bracket reusing these bolts. PIC 7
- Place the cover over the bracket and the top stud on the starter that you removed the plastic cap from in Step 4. Make sure the protective sheathing is positioned to protect the top oil line from the rear edge of the cover. PIC 8 Using the included acorn nuts and flat washers on the stud and the socket head cap screw, attach the cover. Tighten securely. PIC 9
- **STEP 8** Replace the pulley cover with the bolts removed in Step 3. Tighten securely.
- **STEP 9** Replace the rear exhaust pipe, if removed. Tighten securely. Plug in the oxygen sensor connector. Place this and the other harness in the slots in the cover and replace the ECU cover.
- **STEP 10** Reconnect the battery cable.

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not issue a warranty on components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.




















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
