EE Radiator Guards Installation Instructions
































Note: Installation of this product requires the use of Enduro Engineering 11-017 radiator braces.

Follow steps 1-5 of the 11-017 instructions if you are installing the 11-017 at the same time as the 12-017 radiator guards.

- 11-017 Radiator Brace Instructions
- 1a Remove the seat (fig. 1a).
- 2a Remove the tank and shrouds (fig. 2a).
- Drain the coolant (fig. 3a). NOTE: you will need to remove the radiator cap to allow the coolant to fully drain. Once the coolant is drained, be sure to put back the drain bolt.
- Using an 8mm T-handle or socket, remove the two mounting bolts for the radiator and louver. (fig. 4a).
- Loosen the top radiator hose clamp only, and disconnect the radiator (fig. 5a)
- If the bike already has the EE radiator braces (11-017) installed, you will need to use a 4mm Allen wrench to remove the black support rods from the radiator brace (Fig. 1). NOTE: Install Rubber Grommets on Radiator Braces as shown prior to installing (Fig 1.1) If the bike did not have EE radiator braces installed you will need to install the outer (017R/L2) piece (without the black support rods) as shown (Fig. 2).
- 3 Connect the rubber bumpers to the back side of the radiator guards using the provided M6x8mm button head bolts (Fig. 3). **NOTE:** For models with a horn, use the provided 6 x 16mm button head bolt and 6mm nylon nut to secure both the rubber bumper and horn bracket. (Fig 3.1)
- Mount the 12-017 radiator guard to the 11-017 radiator braces using four M6x16mm button head bolts at the rod locations, and three M6x8mm button head bolts on outside (Fig. 4 & 5). NOTE: It may be helpful to only finger tighten all of the bolts until they have all been started, then go back and tighten each one.
- Put the radiator and brace/guard assembly into location over the bosses on the frame, connect the upper radiator hose and tighten the clamp at this time (Fig. 6).
- Using the provided M6x16mm hex head bolts and nylon spacers, fasten the radiator and brace/guard assembly to the frame (Fig. 7). With the 3 supplied M6x10mm button head bolts, attach part 017R/L2 to part 017R/L1.

- 7 If not already done, repeat the previous steps on the opposite side of the bike.
- Use the supplied rubber straps to secure your radiator shrouds.

OPTIONAL: If you would like the shrouds to fit tighter to the radiator, using a 3/8" drill bit, drill a hole on the outside edge of each factory hole (Fig 9).

- 9 Replenish the engine coolant.
- Connect the fuel tank and shrouds, now using the provided rubber straps to secure the shroud as shown (Fig. 8).
- Connect the seat.
- Have fun and ride safe!
