

1. Remove the seat (FIG 1)
2. Using a 4mm Allen Wrench, remove the 5 allen head bolts from the shroud. (FIG 2)
3. Using an 8mm T handle or Socket, remove the bolt holding the shroud to the radiator. (FIG 3)
4. Remove the OEM Radiator Louver by pressing the two out tabs inward and forward. (FIG 4)
5. Using a closed end 8mm Wrench, remove the two bolts holding the radiator to the frame of the motorcycle. (FIG 5)
6. Take one of the brackets label 12-9019-02 and mount it to the bolt holes from step 5 using 2 of the provided M6X25 bolts. (FIG 6) **Make sure the stamped part number is facing the frame.**
7. Depending on what side you started with, take either the 12-9013-03L or 12-9013-03R. (L for left, R for right) and mount it to the outside of the radiator using 2 of the provided M6x16 bolts. Tighten using a closed end 8mm Wrench (FIG 7) **Make sure the stamped part number is facing inward towards the frame so front guard mounting holes are facing forward.**
8. Take either the 12-9013-01L or 12-9013-01R, depending on what side you are working on, and line it up to both brackets you mounted in steps 6 and 7. There should be 4 mounting holes on the outside edge, and 3 mounting holes on the inside, or frame side edge. Using 7 of the provided 5x16 Socket head bolts, mount the front guard to the mounting brackets. Tighten using a 4mm Allen Wrench. (FIG 8)
9. Replace shroud using the same bolts you removed in steps 2 and 3.
10. Repeat steps 2 through 9 on opposite side.
11. Replace Seat.
12. Have fun and enjoy your next ride!
