


INSTALLATION


Adjust center anchor strap, running on one side or the other of center mounts or obstacles. Position J-hook in center of tread and bottom side release buckle so it's not on the corner edge of tire. Tension strap and secure extra webbing with strap keeper (or trim to length leaving 12" or more for easy installation, singe webbing end with lighter to prevent fraying).

Crisscross straps behind tire in an X pattern, going above or below center mount or other obstacles. Position side release buckles in center of tire tread on bottom for easy access to tension and re-tension as needed. Secure excess webbing (or trim if desired).

Tension all straps. Check anchor straps after driving a few miles and re-tension if needed as loads compress and shift.








SECURING GEAR


Secure the Cactus Canteen and Armadillo Bag by hanging on J-hook with bag tucked into the pocket. Buckle straps through daisy chain webbing and secure center strap. Cactus Canteen and Armadillo Bag can be filled, burped or fitted with pour spout while suspended from J-hook.


Pocket flap can be tucked into pocket to create second open pocket, or it can be fully or partially closed with hook-and-loop to accommodate tools and other essentials.



EXCESS WEBBING

The Overland Sling is designed to fit over tires up to 40". Extra webbing can be managed in the layered or rolled method as shown below. Or, if you do not plan to mount the Sling on a larger tire, cut extra webbing, leaving at least 12" and singe ends with lighter to prevent fraying.





After gathering extra webbing, secure with the sewn-in hook-and-loop tabs.




TIP: Recovery gear, traction ramps and other essentials also can be secured to the spare tire with the Overland Sling.




HOSE ACCESS

For quick access to drinking and wash water, shower attachment and other water hoses with universal quick connect can be routed through drain holes at bottom of Sling.




THEFT DETERRENT

Thread GL's 82" QuickLoop security cable through one or both metal grommets and loop through wheel to deter the "grab and dash" thief.



SHOW YOUR PATCHES


Customize your Overland Sling with hook-and-loop patches by folding or tucking pocket flap to expose hook fabric.



TIP: Use a pressure washer or hose nozzle to remove mud and dirt. Air dry. Use vinyl cleaner to preserve and enhance appearance.

Giant Loop's waterproof Possibles Pouches and Rogue or Revelstoke Dry Bags can be secured to the webbing MOLLE-style panels using included straps or Pronghorn or Cinch Straps.


Rogue Dry Bag™
