# ZETA 30 mm lowdown inner kit for front fork SHOWA Twin Chamber (AOS) Type



## 1.Important notes

- · Special knowledge and skills are required for installation. Careless work may cause an unexpected accident or failure.
- · Please contact us or suspension pro shops if you have any problem for installing this kit.
- · Please refer your service manual for removing suspension from the bike, and disassembly of the main body.
- · If any defect is found, stop work and contact us.
- · Do not process or modify the product. It may cause an accident or damage.
- · Please use safety eyeglasses etc. when working, please be careful not to get injured.




### 3.Installation

#### Steps

- 1) Disassemble the damper cartridge.
- \*Refer your service manuals for disassembling damper cartridges
- \*No need to remove the spring.



- 2) Remove spring spacer from damper cartridge.
- 3) Install our spring spacer.



- 4) Remove the lock nut at the lower end of the piston rod.
- 5) To prevent scratches on the oil seal of the cylinder head, wrap the seal tape around the threaded part on piston rod.
- \*Seal tape is not included in this kit, please purchase it separately.
- 6) Pull out the rebound damper.
- 7) Apply fork oil to the collar O ring and insert it in the cylinder of the damper cartridge.
- \*Insert the collar with the narrower outer diameter side first.
- 8) Use a pipe or rod, about 50 to 60 cm in length and about 20 mm in diameter, push the collar all the way to the bottom of the cylinder.
- \*Please use plastic pipe or rod instead of metal to avoid damage to the cylinder.
- 9) Return the rebound damper to the damper cartridge, peel off the seal tape wrapped around the threaded part, and install the locknut.
- 10) Pour the fork oil into the damper cartridge and bleed out air.

#### About the amount of fork oil –

- ★When the service manual shows "oil level". please follow it.
- ★When the service manual shows "Amount of oil", reduce the recommended amount by 4ml. Example: Recommended amount 248ml →244ml (CRF450R '21)
- 11) Assemble the base valve ASSY and bleed out air.
- 12) Assemble the front fork and install it on to the bike.
