#### **WARNING!**

Improper installation may result in chatengine damage or an electrical short.

#### Installation instructions:

- Start by removing the seat on your Street Glide or Road Glide motorcycle.
- 2. Once the seat is removed, locate the 12-position male connector with rubber lanyard attached, this is the P&A accessory plug you will plug our Bluetooth bypass adapter into. (See picture below)



- Simply pull out the lanyard from the connector and connect our Bluetooth bypass adapter.
- Turn the bike on and search for new Bluetooth devices, look for "other devices" DW-BT02 then "connect". (see picture below)

# DW-BT02

To pair an Apple Watch with your iPhone, go to the Apple Watch app.

NOTE: Once our device is connected via Bluetooth, you will see a tiny blue light on the back of our adapter's plastic housing, opposite side of out NAMZ sticker.

- Now that you are connected, you can pair to your phone and listen using Apple CarPlay via your phones Bluetooth or by connecting the phones chargig/data cable into the lightening plug port.
